



Study Course on Capital, volume 1

The Alliance for Workers' Liberty in London will be running a study course on Marx's *Capital*, volume 1, between 10 October and 12 December.

The course is ten sessions, run over ten weeks. It is so designed that it can be followed by reading Otto Rühle's abridgement of *Capital* volume 1 (about four or five pages of reading each week), though of course we encourage participants to read Marx's full original text.

Copies of Rühle's text are available from the course organisers, price £1.50 post free, and it can also be downloaded free from the web (see below).

The emphasis in each session is on discussion and participation, rather than just a lecture.

Each session in the course will be repeated three times (Sunday midday, Sunday evening, and Monday evening) so that the maximum number of people can follow the course. You may normally choose to attend on a Sunday midday, for example, but if one week that is difficult for you, you can take the Monday evening session that particular week. Or vice versa.

The course will run from session 1 on Sunday 10 October and Monday 11 October through to session 10 on Sunday 12 December and Monday 13 December.

Registration for the course costs £10 (to cover room hire, copying costs, and so on).
