

RESOLUTION FOR LCI CONFERENCE 1981

(A) (S) This conference adopts the following events as the focus for LCI activity over the next year:

- (a) to organise a meeting at the Young Socialists conference;
- (b) to organise a series of meetings in as many towns as possible in the run-up to Party Conference as part of a campaign to win support for the LCI model resolution;
- (c) to organise a fringe meeting at Party Conference;
- (d) to organise a conference towards the end of the year for Labour Party members and trade unionists to discuss the background to the present situation in Ireland and the campaign for a new policy.

Proposed: Bruce Robinson (Islington South CLP)

- (e) to send a copy of the LCI model res to all CLPs asking them to vote + discuss res. + ask Tudele. to take on to branches.

(B) AMENDMENTS TO THE DRAFT CONSTITUTION

1. In 9, delete from "...and will ensure that" to the end and replace by:

"Area councils and local groups shall elect delegates to the annual conference in proportion to their paid-up membership."

2. In 10, delete 2nd sentence and replace by:

"The ten additional members shall be elected by annual conference in a manner which reflects the current size and distribution of the paid-up membership. The distribution of the NC members shall be proposed by the outgoing NC for a decision by annual conference."

3. In 10, 3rd sentence, delete from "where possible" to the end of the sentence.
